

What is EEE Program?

Starting **January 1, 2021**, producers of Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) will be individually accountable and financially responsible for collecting and reusing, refurbishing or recycling their products when consumers discard them.

Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) is equipment that is:

- designed for use with an electric current
- has a voltage of less than 1,000 volts for alternating current and less than 1,500 volts for direct current
- weighs no more than 250 kg
- not intended to be used permanently as part of a building or structure

What do you need to do before you bring in your eligible equipment?

Follow these steps before you take your device to a participating Tbooth wireless store.

1. Backup all your data before clearing/resetting your device such as smartphone, tablet, smart watch, etc.
2. Bring your device and any accessories that you need to discard.
